Workshop with Lynne Damianos

A special opportunity to learn about the unique aspects of architectural photography will be led by professional photographer Lynne Damianos in the Fort Andross building in Brunswick, Maine on Saturday March 31st. The workshop is for amateur and professional photographers shooting digital or film.

Topics in the seminar include:

- How to work effectively with architects, designers, real estate companies and contractors
- Site evaluation and preparing for the shoot
- Style and lighting techniques
- Equipment and gear needed (note: this workshop is intended for photographers working in the 35mm format, either digital or film)
- Perspective control
- Weather issues
- Post production and digital imaging's role in architectural photography

Ms. Damianos will lead a morning session with a lecture/slideshow and discussion of the topics shown above, with time for questions and answers from 9:30 - noon.

Those who register for the full day session will break for lunch at noon, then Ms. Damianos will lead the group on a photo shoot around the Fort Andross building, giving participants a chance to try some of the techniques she has described. A critique of some of the images shot during the session will be offered at the end of the session.
