

PROPOSED BY-LAWS AMENDMENT

Through some combination of past resignations or something, the club finds itself in the position that nearly every seat on the EB is up for election this spring. The intention has always been to have only about half the seats come up in any given year, but the by-laws presently allow for no formal way to correct the present imbalance. There's nothing to be done about this year's expiring seats, but it might be advisable to give the Board the authority to restore the balance going forward. Accordingly, the following amendment to Article V, Section 2(B) is proposed.

As presently written:

B. Electees filling a position with an expiring term shall serve a term of two (2) years; they shall assume office on June 1. Electees filling a vacant position shall assume office immediately and serve until the expiration of the vacated term. No individual may serve in the same capacity for more than two (2) full consecutive terms.

Proposed amended language:

- An electee filling a position with an expiring term shall assume office on June 1 and serve a term of two (2) years, provided however that prior to the election the Board may specify that their election is to a term of a single year only. An electee filling a vacant position shall assume office immediately and serve until the expiration of the vacated term. No individual may be elected to the same position in more than two consecutive elections.

The change to the last sentence is intended to eliminate confusion and game-playing about the meaning of a full term.
