The PCC Gallery Committee invites all club members to participate in a photographic exhibit at the Graves Library in Kennebunkport, ME. This is a wonderful opportunity to showcase your work, and we hope many of you will choose to submit your best photographs for consideration. The prints will be displayed in the library, where the general public can view the exhibit.

The Portland Camera Club Gallery Committee will curate this exhibit. Up to two images per member will be considered. Electronic submissions will be **due by August 1st**. The Committee will select images to be displayed in the first week of August. The artists that are selected will be responsible for delivering their **ready-to-hang images on September 2nd 2025**. An electronic submission form will be sent out shortly. All submissions must be sent using this form. This is a members-only event, Dues must be paid before your images will be hung up.

All images should be at least 8x10 inches in size. The maximum size is 30x36 inches for frames with standard proportions. Panoramas may be longer than 36 inches. Images can be matted and framed, or mounted on a 1/4" soft-core architectural board. Images can also be on metal, wood, canvas or Artiplaq. All prints must have a sturdy hanging wire, string or hanger attached to the back of the image. Sawtooth hangers are not acceptable, because they will not work with our Stas hanging system. There are no restrictions on color of mats or frames.

Please provide the following information on a sheet on the back of the print:

- Title of print
- Name of maker
- Contact phone number and email address of maker

The Committee will place labels with this information next to the print on the wall.

Exhibited images may be for sale. Sale transactions will be between the buyer and seller with no involvement of either the Portland Camera Club or The Graves Library. If someone is interested in purchasing a print, it will be up to the buyer to contact the seller directly for pricing using the contact information on the label next to the print. The maker, and not the Portland Camera Club or The Graves Library, assumes the risk of loss or damage to the prints; makers will be asked to sign a form agreeing to these requirements.
